## ACTIONS TAKEN, MAJOR PROJECT UPDATES, AND OTHER MILESTONES

- Last week over 1600 claimants attended Claimant Reemployment sessions at one-stop centers around the state, with an increase in Metro area participation.
- Assisting with recruitment for the \$2.9M ARRA funded Albany & Easter Railroad track upgrade project near Albany.
- Mandatory Claimant Reemployment attendance in Hermiston (consequences are denial of UI benefits for one week) have increased participation from an average of 60% (matching statewide figures) to 84% for the previous week.
- Planning continues for a Veterans Career and Community Resource Fair in Jackson County, which will be held at the Rogue Valley Mall. 2,500 veterans in Region 8 (Jackson and Josephine counties) have been invited to attend.
- LMI/Green Jobs – started collaborating with the Oregon Department of Energy regarding data on green energy sectors, specifically those sectors involved in renewable energy production.
- Federal legislation (HR 4691 – the Temporary Extension Act of 2010) was signed by President Obama on March 2. This extends the deadline for federal UI payments including EUC, FAC, and 100% federal EB subsidy by 30 days - from February 28 to April 4. This extension allows some claimants to qualify for new tiers of EUC after February 28, thus extending their benefit payment period.

## UPCOMING PLANNED ACTIONS, MAJOR PROJECTS, DEADLINES, AND GRANT OPPORTUNITIES

- Re-applied for ARRA Broadband Grant, which would allow us to upgrade computer bandwidth at Employment Service field offices around the state. Department of Commerce/NTIA has opened Round 2 funding as of March 15 – notification of awards will start in June, with all awards granted by September. As we encourage claimants to take an Initial Skills Review (ISR), we are finding bandwidth limitations are creating problems, such as dropped iMatchSkills and ISR sessions.
